

2020 IRS Documentation Requirement

Dependent Residency Documentation

The IRS requires taxpayers claiming any dependents to provide documentation that qualifying dependent(s) reside at their home for more than 6 months during the tax year. The tax return cannot be filed without this documentation for **each dependent** on your return and will delay your refund if not submitted. It can be a variety of forms, but it must show:

THE DEPENDENTS NAME & TAXPAYERS ADDRESS

Forms of documentation include but not limited to:

- o School records, 1098-t form, statement, or report card
- o Medical records, insurance documents, or Rx labels
- o 1095-A or 1095-B health coverage tax form showing dependents
- o Drivers license or identification card
- o Landlord or property manager lease agreement or statement
- o Child care provider records
- o Placement agency statement
- o Bank or investment account records
- o Child's w-2 or 1099 form / employment documentation or letter
- o Social service records or statement
- o Place of worship or church statement
- o Social security card or birth certificate with mailing address
